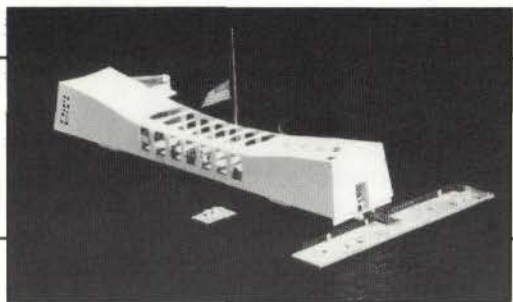


The 50th anniversary is Dec. 7, 1991.

THE DAY OF INFAMY



The National Memorial over the sunken USS Arizona in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii

December 7, 1941 — the “day of infamy” — may be the most important date in 20th century American history. After the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, America led the way to victory in World War II and our nation has played a dominant role in world affairs ever since. Although the U.S. government has chosen not to issue a coin for the 50th anniversary, it is an occasion that must be permanently commemorated — to honor those who fought and died on that fateful day, and in the ensuing war to safeguard liberty.

Over 2,000 Americans lost their lives in the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. All eight American battleships in the Pacific Force were damaged; three were destroyed, including the USS Arizona with a loss of 1,102 sailors. Today a National Memorial covers the hull of the sunken USS Arizona. Here, on Dec. 7, 1991, the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association will host the 50th Anniversary Observance Ceremonies, whose guests of honor will be President Bush and Secretary of Defense Cheney.

Fittingly, the 50th Anniversary Pearl Harbor proofs have been authorized by the Association and will be issued by the Royal Hawaiian Mint in Honolulu, from a site flown over by Japanese planes on that awful Sunday morning.
